First, let me thank everyone for making the commitment to travel and give up your weekend for Coyote Baseball. It's an investment that will come back to you as a parent; "just not yet".

I want to make a few observations! When you hit the road you never know what kind of conditions you will find on the other end of the road. We found a big field that created a big liability for the outfielder that let a ball gets through him. A portable mound that by rule was too high. It also had no back side or sides to be comfortable throwing to one of the bases. That first game was a 7AM start with a 6 AM warm-up. The Coyotes seemed to handle all these exceptions in stride.

The top four batters in our line-up hit .441 with an on base percentage of .472. The top four in our line-up got only 1 walk in 36 at bats and no walks out of the top two hitters.

The bottom four batters in our line-up hit .080 with an on base percentage of .258. The bottom of the line-up had 6 walks and 11 strikeouts.

Game 1 4th Inning; Coyotes on defense. Inning starts with 3 walks. Inning has 6 walks and 2 errors. 7 runs scored on 4 hits. Hello Mr. Baseball!

Game 1 the Coyotes score 1 run in the first. The 2nd inning we get a walk and a pass ball and a runner to 2nd with no outs and then we strikeout 3 times. If we get 2 balls put into play we score a run. Hello Mr. Baseball. The 3rd inning starts with base hit, error, base hit, and the bases are loaded. The next batter hits a ball back to the pitcher, a strikeout, and pop-up to left. In that inning we score 3 runs on aggressive base running but we can't put together a big inning. Hello Mr. Baseball. The 4th inning starts with a walk and a stolen base. Then we get an out trying to steal 3rd base down 8 runs. The next two batters strikeout. Game Over.

Game 2 the Coyotes face 6 batters over the minimum. We walk 3 batter but they don't score. Logan starts that game and K's 5 of the first 11 batters. No errors in the field. We pick off a runner at 2nd base.

Game 3 starts with a 3B, 3B, Walk, 1B. Thomas comes into pitch. He faces 13 batters with 1 walk. He gets 6 ground balls. He gets 3 infield pop-ups for outs. He gives up 2 hits, one in the first inning and one in the 3rd inning. No runs scored. Hello Mr. Baseball.

This is a game that has 12 walks, but only 2 in the first 3 innings.

This is a tournament that the Coyotes played 3 games and did not get a pitching out from Patrick, Joey S., or Steven. I don't see that ever happening again.

The second position in the batting order continues to hurt our offense. Twice in the second game we got it right. Matt is on first and Joey W. hit two balls to the right side (one for a base hit) and Matt comes to third. Hello Mr. Baseball you gotta like that.

The guys that can really run continue to strikeout trying to lift the ball instead on trying to hit it on the ground and beat out a base hit.

In 6 innings of the tournaments we gave up two or more walks. That extends the inning and the number of pitches that have to be thrown. Four times in the tournament we committed an error the next batter after a walk. The Coyotes only committed 7 errors in the 3 games.

During the tournament, baserunners missed a sign 23 times.

The Coyotes lost two games. Game 1 we scored 4 runs but they had a 4 run inning and a 8 run inning. Game 2 we scored 15 runs but they had a 4 run inning and a 8 run inning.
